

ICCN 2018 Book Donation Initiative

The distribution of global cancer nursing education resources is unbalanced. There are insufficient cancer textbooks in low and middle-income countries where cancer nurses, educators and researchers do not get adequate access to adequate professional books.

To support resource sharing and enhance cancer nursing development in underdeveloped areas, the ISNCC Communications Committee will launch the 2nd book donation activity at ICCN 2018. This activity was greatly supported by all the ISNCC members and participants at ICCN 2017 with 20 textbooks in English and 16 textbooks in Chinese donated to 18 nurses from underdeveloped areas. This enhanced the internal and external communication of ISNCC as well as promoting the sharing of educational resources.

We invite all ICCN 2018 delegates to bring books to donate or exchange.

The textbook donations criteria will be as follows:

- Published within the last 10 years
- Legal public publication
- Content range:
 - o Cancer nursing theories
 - o Clinical technologies and practices on cancer nursing
 - o Research methods in cancer nursing
 - o Any text related to cancer nursing

A table will be set up at ICCN and manned by Communications Committee Members. Please ensure the textbooks you bring to ICCN follow the text book donations criteria.
